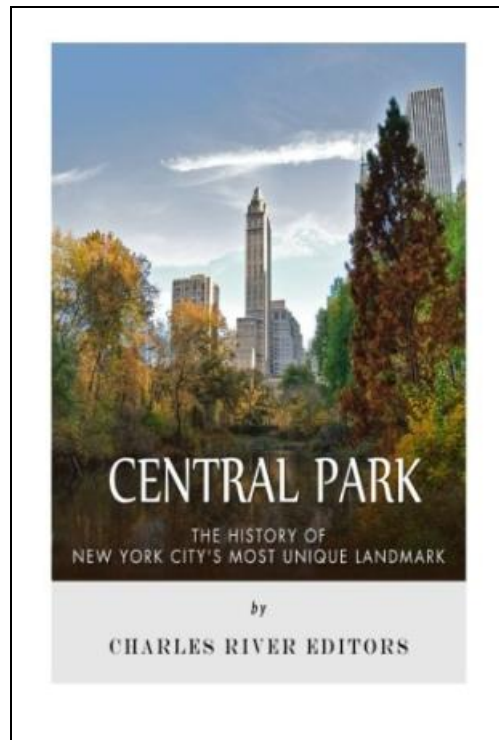

As actor Haley Joel Osment once put it, My favorite place is Central Park because you never know what you re going to find there. I also like that when I look out the windows of surrounding hotels, it s seems like I m looking out over a forest. In 1811, an ambitious plan was laid out that would transform Manhattan s grid into 2,028 blocks, from Houston Street to 155th Street. Forests would be cut down, hills razed, ponds and streams filled. It took years to survey, and years to complete: at different points in time, one might have seen a long avenue laid out, unpaved, with a scattering of as-yet-unattached six-story buildings amid boulders yet to be cleared and soon-to-be-demolished shantytowns. Ironically, almost no parks were incorporated into the plan,...
