Excerpt from The British Gynecological Journal, Vol. 20: Being the Journal of the British Gynecological Society; May, 1904 Speculum, the os uteri was eroded and some purulent discharge was seen exuding from it. I diagnosed fungous endometritis, and recommended that the uterus should be curetted. The patient went into a nursing home and, under anesthesia, I dilated the cervix uteri up to No. 14 Hegar, and scraped away a very hypertrophied endometrium. The uterus, after having been swabbed out with liquor iodi, was packed with iodoform gauze for forty-eight hours. At the end of that time the gauze was removed, and a vaginal douche of 1 in solution of perchloride of mercury was ordered to be given night and morning whilst the patient remained in the home. (this is my usual method of treatment after curetting the uterus.) The patient made a perfectly uneventful recovery and returned home well at the end of three weeks. I saw nothing more of her until the beginning of last November when she again consulted me for a recurrence of the menorrhagia. She then informed...
